John D. Kasarda is a Kenan Distinguished Professor of Management and the director of the Frank Hawkins Kenan Institute of Private Enterprise at the Kenan-Flagler Business School at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

An internationally recognized expert on transportation infrastructure and competitive logistics, Dr. Kasarda has published more than 70 scholarly articles and nine books on those subjects as well as on other competitiveness issues and urban development. He is frequently quoted on those areas of expertise in the Wall Street Journal, the New York Times and other national and international periodicals.

Dr. Kasarda serves on the editorial boards of a variety of major professional journals and as a consultant to airlines and airports. He has also served as a consultant to the Carter, Reagan, Bush, and Clinton administrations and has testified numerous times before U.S. Congressional committees on economic development and competitiveness issues. He is the executive program instructor on issues of corporate relocation, America's changing demographics and new domestic and global markets to such clients as Federal Express, Prudential Insurance Company, Bank of America and the Urban Land Institute.

Dr. Kasarda received his B.S. and M.B.A. (with Distinction) from Cornell University and his Ph.D. from the University of North Carolina. He has received grants and awards from many organizations, including the Federal Aviation Administration, the National Science Foundation, the National Academy of Sciences, the World Bank, and the U.S. Agency for International Development. He has been designated as a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and a Senior Fellow and Trustee of the Urban Land Institute.
