Bio:

Michael "Mac" McNulty is an environmental, health and safety extension specialist.

Mac provides hazardous waste operations, emergency response and incident spill response education, training, exercise evaluations, and program development to North Carolina businesses and local, state and federal agencies. Over the past year, Mac provided initial and refresher training to the HazMat spill teams at manufacturers in Wilmington, Winston-Salem, and Raleigh, saving them \$250 thousand to \$5 million in insurance costs.

Mac evaluates an annual joint hazardous material spill response drill for two federal agencies in the RTP. He has also instructed DOT HazMat Transportation training for a variety of audiences, from paper mill personnel to VA Hospital EHS staff.

Mac has more than 25 years experience in chemistry, safety and health, and remediation/emergency response. He developed and managed environmental health and safety programs for a paper coatings and inks business, automotive after-market chemical products company, metal fabrication manufacturer, and environmental remediation company.

Mac has created and trained spill response teams, trained and supervised remediation field crews, applied for and maintained a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit, and managed and disposed of solid and hazardous wastes. Mac is an authorized OSHA trainer for General Industry.
