Robert T. Dail retired in November, 2008 after serving 33 years in the United States Army. At retirement, he was the senior military logistics professional in the Department of Defense.

General Dail's last tour on active duty was as the 15th Director of the Defense Logistics Agency. General Dail assumed this position in August 2006. The Defense Logistics Agency, headquartered at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, provides the full range of logistics, acquisition, and technical services to the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps and other federal agencies.

Prior to his duties at DLA, General Dail served as the Deputy Commander, United States Transportation Command, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois. USTRANSCOM is a Unified Command reporting to the Secretary of Defense, executing the nation's global defense transportation system with components from the Army, Navy and Air Force.

During his military career, General Dail commanded and led logistics and transportation units from the platoon to national level; across the full range of Army combat and joint operational capabilities. He is a combat veteran with extensive experience in national level logistics.

In March, 2009, he joined Supreme Group, Inc., a global logistics services company headquartered in The Netherlands. General Dail served as President of Supreme Group, USA located in the Reston Town Center, Reston, Virginia from 2009-2013. In January 2013, General Dail was promoted to Chief Commercial Officer of Supreme Group, Inc with global responsibilities for Development, Communications, and Strategic Planning. General Dail departed Supreme in June 2014 and now heads RTDAIL Enterprises, consulting on a wide range of Government related activities.

In addition to his consulting activities, General Dail serves as a member of the following Boards of Directors: LMI Government Consulting, McLean, Virginia; iDirect Government Technologies, Fairfax, Virginia; and ADS Technologies, Inc., Virginia Beach, Virginia. He also serves on the Flag Officer Advisory Council, Arizona State University, Tempe, AZ; and the Board of Directors for the Institute for Defense Business, Chapel Hill, NC.

General Dail currently resides in Leesburg, Virginia.
