David Bosco is an associate professor at Indiana University's School of Global and International Studies and a contributing editor at Foreign Policy magazine. He is the author of "Rough Justice: The International Criminal Court in a World of Power Politics" and "Five to Rule Them All: The UN Security Council and the Making of the Modern World," both published by Oxford University Press.

Professor Bosco has earned a JD from Harvard University as well as an MPhil from Cambridge University in International Relations. He focuses on the political dynamics of international organizations and international law and is currently researching a book on ocean governance. He is also continuing to research aspects of the United Nations system, with a focus on the Security Council's performance, and the International Criminal Court.
