Scott served as an officer in the US Navy for 27 years. He held several positions leading strategy, policy and innovation efforts, working directly for 3- and 4-star commanders in the Indo-Pacific region and Washington, DC. His projects included both disruption and counter-disruption against peer competitors, ranging across elements of strategy, operations, assessment, training, strike, cyber, advanced technology and logistics. His primary focus was the use of war gaming to uncover key opportunities and risks. He also held senior policy positions, with a focus in Indo-Asia, on the Joint Chiefs of Staff (J-5), Pacific Fleet (N00 WAR), and US Seventh Fleet (N00 EA). At sea he served in Cruiser and Destroyer ships, commanding USS Mustin (DDG 89) and, most recently, USS Zumwalt (DDG 1000).

After transitioning from the service in 2019, he joined Globe Environment Technologies to field clean waste-to-energy technology and also founded Alfa Strategy to apply military wargame techniques to business.

Scott holds master's degrees from Stanford University in International Policy and the US Naval War College in National Security and Strategic Studies. At the Naval War College, he was a member of the Halsey Alfa Advanced Research and Wargaming Project.
