Dee Mewbourne retired as a Vice Admiral in 2022 after 40 years of service and is currently pursuing an executive leadership position in the private sector. He completed the Navy's nuclear power training program and numerous prestigious leader development courses and is a distinguished graduate of the U.S. Naval Test Pilot School.
