LOG21 is taught workshop-style using a combination of lectures, guest speakers, panels, and in-class exercises

### SMALL GROUP PROJECTS

Participants will be placed into small groups during the week for discussion and use of tools and processes around key logistics challenges approved by faculty. The "problem directions" are comprised of important issues in the work environment as well as national and international strategic topics.

Throughout the week, participants meet with their small group to apply what they learn in program sessions to their shared challenges. At the end of the week, participants present their group's findings to a panel of senior logistics leaders who share their feedback and input with the class.
